Who Are We?

Barnyard Gardens is a small farm business owned and operated by Paul Feenan & Kirsten Workman. Our 5-acre farm is located near Phillips Lake in Mason County, not far from the waters of Pickering Passage and Oakland Bay. Besides our flock of laying hens; we also raise started pullets and cockerels; have five large greenhouses where we grow veggies, herbs, and propagate plants; a nursery with annual and perennial plants, shrubs, and trees; small vegetable gardens; and we operate a landscape design and consulting business.

Our Flock

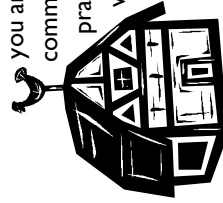
We are the proud farmers of a flock of roughly 100 laying hens and a handful of very happy roosters. The flock is comprised of Barred Rock, Red Sex Link, Black Sex Link, Silver Laced Wyandotte, Black Australorp, Araucana, and Rhode Island Red hens. We raise them from day-old chicks in our brooder, move them to the hen house as pullets, and then introduce them to the great outdoors. We feed them certified organic chicken feed, veggie scraps, and whole grains. They are never in cages and have plenty of room to nest, scratch, fly, and do their favorite "chicken activities."

Our Eggs

We strive to provide our customers with the freshest, healthiest eggs in the most sustainable way. We collect eggs at least twice a day, wash them, and refrigerate them immediately. You can buy them on our farm or sign up for our Egg CSA and pick them up weekly in either Shelton or Olympia. When picking up your eggs, please refrigerate them as soon as possible and always cook them thoroughly once you get them home.

Local, Sustainable Agriculture

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. What does that mean? It means that by investing in our farm by purchasing a "share" of our eggs,
